

## Dakota City City Council Meeting Minutes

The Dakota City City Council met in regular session on June 5, 2008, in the Dakota City City Council Chambers. Notice of the meeting was given in advance by posting the notice at three separate locations in Dakota City. Notice of the meeting was also given to the Mayor and Council.

Mayor Cantrell called the meeting to order at 5:30 P.M., with the following members present: Cahill, Carson, Larson, and Schovanec. City Administrator, Robert Peters was excused from the meeting due to illness. Deputy Clerk, Tiffany Bligh was present in his place. Following the pledge of allegiance, the Mayor advised of the available information regarding the Open Meetings Act.

During the public comment period, Mr. Miller requested the council consider hiring him as the City's animal control when the current contract has expired. Mayor Cantrell suggested he leave an application at City Hall.

Moved by Carson, seconded by Larson, that the consent agenda for June 5, 2008, be approved. Moved by Cahill, seconded by Schovanec, that the Interlocal Agreement with the Village of Jackson and the City of Dakota City, revising the current Water Testing/Water Treatment services be approved. Roll call vote: Ayes – Cahill, Carson, Larson, and Schovanec. Nays-None. Motion passed.

Moved by Larson, seconded by Carson, that the Home Investment Partnership Intergovernmental between the City of Dakota City, NE, the City of South Sioux City, NE and the City of Sioux City, IA be approved. Ayes – Carson, Larson, Schovanec and Cahill. Nays – None. Motion Passed.

Moved by Larson, seconded by Schovanec, that the City of Dakota City get assistance from the Nebraska Rural Water in Wahoo, Nebraska for a Water/Sewer Rate Study in order to review current water rate structures. Ayes – Larson, Schovanec, Cahill and Carson. Nays – None. Motion Passed.

The Council deferred action on street striping pending discussion with the County.

After discussion, the Mayor and Council will consider assistance from SIMPCO depending on Mr. Peter's return to work from illness.

Moved by Carson, seconded by Cahill that Resolution 2008-3 be approved. This resolution provides for payment of Highway Allocation Fund Pledge Bonds in the principal amount of \$150,000. Ayes – Larson, Schovanec, Carson, Cahill. Nays – None. Motion Passed.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
