The Dakota City City Council met in regular session on Thursday, January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Moved by Haase, seconded by Schovanec to approve a Special Designated Liquor License for a Big Game Conservation Association, Northeast Chapter event to be held at the Dakota City Fire Hall on February 15, 2020 Roll call vote: Voting Aye: Rasmussen, Schovanec, and Haase. Nays: None. Motion carried.
