**No one should be at City Hall who has COVID19;
who has been exposed to someone with COVID19 within the last 14 days;
who has a temperature over 100.4 degrees; who has a new or worsening cough,
difficulty breathing, body aches, sore throat, changes in taste or smell; or has
recently traveled outside the country.**

PUBLIC

- The public is encouraged to continue handling business via drive thru window, mail, email, fax, drop box or telephone.
- Two individual members of the public will be allowed in the Customer Service Office at any given time.
- No additional parties will be admitted into the Customer Service Office.
- No waiting inside City Hall.
- You are strongly encouraged to wear face coverings.
- Members of the public must leave immediately when transaction is complete.
- Adhere to minimum social distancing guideline of 6 feet (marked X) within Customer Service Office.
- No public restrooms
- Members of the public who do not observe safety provisions will be asked to conduct their business via drive thru window, mail, email, fax, drop box or telephone.
- Forms of payment accepted: Cash, Check, Money Order, Credit/Debit Card.
